

ALABAMA EMERGENCY NET “Y” PREAMBLE

(Red is for information only and should not be read)

Calling all members of the AENY Training Net. This is **(callsign)** located in **(city/neighborhood)**, my name is **(name)**. I'll be your net control station for this session.

The Alabama Emergency Net “Y” is in liaison with the Alabama Emergency Net System and the National Traffic System. The net sponsor is the Gadsden Amateur Radio Club. Club information may be found at www.garc.org.

This net meets every Tuesday at 8:30p.m. Alabama local time on the Gadsden Amateur Radio Club 147.160 MHz repeater with a positive offset and a tone of 100 Hz. If this repeater is out of service, the net will be held on the local EMA 146.820 MHz repeater with a negative offset and a tone of 192.8 Hz. The purpose of this net is to train members to be more proficient operators during emergency situations and when handling traffic. All radio amateur operators are invited to participate.

This is a directed net. Do we have a station to serve as our liaison to Alabama Traffic Net Mike? Traffic will be listed before roll call and will be passed on or off frequency at the direction of net control.

Stations are asked to check in when the first letter in the prefix of their call sign is requested. When checking in, please give your call sign using standard phonetics, your name and location. A stand-by will be taken for late stations to participate after roll call. Stations desiring to participate must give their call sign to be acknowledged.

This is **(your call sign)** standing by for any station with emergency or priority traffic. **(pass emergency, then priority traffic immediately)**

Are there any stations desiring to list formal WRITTEN traffic, please call now?

(pass traffic going out of state first)

Are there any stations with informal traffic, please call now? **(make arrangements to move this off frequency or wait until after net closes)**

If you have business or announcements for the net, please call now.

Are there any mobile or portable stations desiring to check in, please call now?

Stations unable to wait for their proper time and place during roll call to check in, may secure now, please do not break the net to secure early.

(Roll should be called in a timely fashion with minimum comments)

We will now begin roll call with station calls beginning with “W”, Then “K”, Then “A”, and then “N”.

Are there any late stations, with any prefix for AENY, call now, this is **(your call sign)**.

Anyone with ham related items for the swap shop, please call now.

Late stations, last chance, call now.

This is **(your call)** closing the AENY training net and returning this repeater to normal amateur use Thanks to all participants.
